CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the CALAPOOIA RIVER, a tributary to the WILLAMETTE RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 11.07 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-50103. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 22, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 1/235 or 0.0043 cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 0.71 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is further limited to an annual volume limitation of 8.3 acre-feet per year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 65680, State Record of Water Right Certificates, **REDUCED IN RATE** by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **OCT 25 2016**, and recorded at Special Order Volume **103**, Page **277** approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-91. This Certificate together with Certificates 91927, 91926, and the applicant's portion of conserved water set forth in Special Order Volume 103, Page **277**, supersede Certificate 65680.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
