CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SLOUGH, a tributary of the POWDER RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 364.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-42470. The date of priority is APRIL 29, 1975. The right is limited to not more than 5.84 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
