CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FARM CREDIT BANK OF SPOKANE W 601 1ST AVE TAF C5 SPOKANE, WA 99220

confirms the right to use the waters of the POWDER RIVER, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM POWDER RIVER TO BE MADE UP BY DIVERSION FROM AN UNNAMED SLOUGH, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 17.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-42472. The date of priority is AUGUST 10, 1976. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.29 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
