confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-5516. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: HAY CREEK AND THREE WELLS, A TRIBUTARY OF JOHN DAY RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: MUNICIPAL USES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.847 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); FURTHER LIMITED TO 0.253 CFS FROM POD 1 (HAY CREEK), 0.218 CFS FROM POD 2 (WELL 6), 0.143 CFS FROM POD 3 (WELL 7) AND 0.233 CFS FROM POD 4 (WELL 8)

DATE OF PRIORITY: JULY 7, 1922

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion (three shallow wells), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion.


The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described; however, water may be applied to lands which are not specifically described above, provided the holder of this right complies with ORS 540.510(3).

This certificate is issued to confirm ADDITIONAL POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 15, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 623, approving Transfer Application 8731, supercedes Certificate 10637, State record of Water Right Certificates.
