confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-34940. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: COLUMBIA RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF PACIFIC OCEAN

PURPOSE OR USE: GENERAL INDUSTRIAL USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 5.4 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: AUGUST 3, 1970

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion. The screen or fish by-pass device must be approved by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in additional point of diversion and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 14, 2006, at Special Order Volume 69, Page 140-143, approving Transfer Application T-10010, and together with Certificate 81969, supercedes Certificate 73396, State record of Water Right Certificates.
