CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WAYNE J. BLAYLOCK RIVERSIDE OR 97917

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH FORK OF THE MALHEUR RIVER AND RESERVOIR NO. 2, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6483, a tributary of the MALHEUR RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 25.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-40680. The date of priority is MARCH 27, 1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.256 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-6483, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 52791, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered october 27, 2016, approving Transfer Application T-11492.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
