 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS' AFFAIRS LOAN P-40895

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the MALHEUR LAKE BASIN for IRRIGATION 43.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7076. The date of priority is JANUARY 18, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.55 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The well shall be cased as necessary in accordance with good practice and if the flow is artesian the works shall include proper capping and control valve to prevent the waste of ground water.

The works shall include an airline and pressure gauge or an access port for a measuring line, adequate to determine the water level elevation in the well at all times.

The water user shall maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a

complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 82709, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 05 2016, approving Transfer Application T-12150.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
