 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of MCKAY CREEK, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 2.41 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-5996. The date of priority is AUGUST 16, 1923. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
2 N	32 E	WM	28	SE NE	HYDRAULICALLY CONNECTED WELL - 540 FEET NORTH AND 410 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion described as follows:

2 N	32 E	WM	28	SE NE	TRANSFER R-52 - 815 FEET NORTH AND 465 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 28
2 N	32 E	WM	34	SW SE	MARION JACK DITCH

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 30, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 1043, approving Transfer Application 7837, and together with Certificate 79662, supercedes Certificate 75447, State record of Water Right Certificates.
