confirms a portion of the right to use the waters of MCKAY RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-584, tributary to UMATILLA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 2.41 ACRES.

A portion of this right was perfected under Permit S-7400. The date of priority is JULY 1, 1924.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of re-diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The point of re-diversion is located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.


**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 30, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 1043, approving Transfer Application 7837, and modifies a portion of the right perfected under Permit S-7400.
