CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN DAVIDSON  
VINCENT, OREGON 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHNSON CREEK, a tributary of PINE CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 1.52 ACRES, LIVESTOCK AND DOMESTIC.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at page 321. The date of priority is 1892.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the place of use description recorded at page 90250, State Record of Water Right Certificates, which described that portion of the right previously confirmed by Certificate 89419, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 27, 2015, approving Transfer Application T-11859. This certificate supersedes Certificate 90250.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
