confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-33946. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: MALHEUR RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF THE SNAKE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 25.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.63 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: OCTOBER 25, 1968

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	GLot	Measured Distances
17 S	47 E	WM	21	NE NW	1	300 FEET SOUTH AND 1980 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 21

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The use of water from the Snake River shall be limited at all times to the quantities of water available at the original point of diversion on the Malheur River described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a totalizing flow meter at the point of diversion in good working order according to manufacturer's specifications. A different plan for measurement of diverted water at each point of diversion that is acceptable to and approved by the Director may be allowed.

The water user shall keep a complete record of the amount of water used each month, and shall submit annually a report which includes the recorded monthly water-use measurements and date of measurement to the Department, unless the Director determines a different reporting frequency is appropriate. The reports may be e-mailed, faxed or mailed.

The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter(s). Where a meter is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.


Additional measurement and reporting conditions, including, but not limited to, additional measuring sites, general water-use information, the place and nature of use of water, and telemetry may be required at the discretion of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 13, 2008, at Special Order Volume 76, Page 435, approving conserved water application CW-55, and together with Certificates 84698, 84699, 84741, and 84867, supercedes Certificate 74021, State record of Water Right Certificates.
