CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD D. STEPHENS  
14400 N ROCK CREEK LANE

confirms the right to use the waters of ROCK CREEK, TRIBUTARY OF THE POWDER RIVER for IRRIGATION of 73.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 291. The dates of priority are APRIL 26, 1884 for 10.0 acres, APRIL 1891 for 34.0 ACRES, MAY 1895 for 29.5 ACRES.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain and operate the measuring device as required by the Department.

The water user shall maintain the headgate as required by the Department.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 13, 2009, at Special Order Volume 78, Page 378, approving Transfer Application 10600, and together with Certificate 85514, supercedes Certificate 82336, State record of Water Right Certificates.
