confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-10099. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the wells. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: WELL 1 AND WELL 2 IN THE CHRISTMAS VALLEY BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 129.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 1.62 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: APRIL 27, 1983

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.


The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn at the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 16, 2012, at Special Order Volume 87 Page 298, approving Transfer Application 8450, and together with Certificate 87225, supercedes Certificate 83291, State record of Water Right Certificates.
