CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

QUAIL VALLEY RANCH, LLC  
2260 MCGILCHRIST STREET SE  
SALEM OR 97302

confirms the right to use the waters of CROOKED RIVER, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 4.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit E-39. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 28, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs), if available at the original point of diversion, SE NE, Section 36, T15S, R15E, WM; SOUTH 9 DEGREES 20 FEET WEST, 28.55 CHAINS FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 36, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgates and measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 7, 2008, at Special Order Volume 74, Page 314, approving Transfer Application 9172, and together with Certificate 83851, supersedes Certificate 83441, State record of Water Right Certificates.
