# CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the well(s). 0.17 CFS FROM WELL 3

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

#### Water use measurement conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices in good working order at each point of appropriation.
- b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of appropriation described.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 18, 2014, at Special Order Volume 93, Page 956, approving Transfer Application 11772 supersedes Certificate 26989, State record of Water Right Certificates.
