CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-50651. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

PURPOSE or USE: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 4.7 ACRES

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The permit shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior permit for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

It is further provided that although declared herein to be for supplemental irrigation, the right allowed herein may, in the interest of conserving the ground water supplies, be exercised at times when water is available in the ground water aquifer provided the total quantity diverted from all sources of supply does not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water right use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.

The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.
