confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-4866. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the wells. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: TWO WELLS IN THE PAULINA MARSH BASIN

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 32.37 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.405 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 13, 1970

The wells are located are follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water that was lawfully available at the original point of appropriation described as follows:


Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 26, 2004, at Special Order Volume 60, Page 139, approving Transfer Application 9256, and together with Certificate 81006, supercedes Certificate 41330, State record of Water Right Certificates.
