confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit G-8676. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of appropriation from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: THREE WELLS WITHIN THE UMATILLA RIVER BASIN

PURPOSE or USE: QUASI-MUNICIPAL

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.56 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS); BEING 0.44 CFS FROM WELL #1, 0.35 CFS FROM CHUCK WAGON WELL, 0.42 CFS FROM WELL #3

DATE OF PRIORITY: MAY 29, 1979

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by a proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated at the additional points of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 58354.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 9, 2005, at Special Order Volume 64, Page 377, approving Transfer Application 9756, supercedes Certificate 58354, State record of Water Right Certificates.
