This right was perfected under Permit G-7293. The date of priority is MARCH 3, 1977. This right is limited to 13.54 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.83 CFS FROM WELL 1, 5.50 CFS FROM WELL 2, AND 7.21 CFS FROM WELL 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL 1: SW1/4 SE1/4, SECTION 9, T 37 S, R 10 E, WM; 550 FEET NORTH AND 3420 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER, SECTION 9.
