confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-7821. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: SLATE CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF APPLGATE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 1.4 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: MARCH 10, 1927

The point of diversion is located as follows:

37 S	6 W	WM	6	SW NW	73 FEET SOUTH AND 468 FEET EAST FROM N1/16 CORNER, SECTION 6

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion together with that diverted at the original point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order at each point of diversion.
- b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 18, 2014, at Special Order Volume 92, Page 817, approving Transfer Application 11656, and together with Certificate 89327, supersedes Certificate 7471, State record of Water Right Certificates.
