confirms the right to use the waters of the Little Walla Walla River, tributary to the Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION on 2.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority date is 1908.

The use is limited to 1.5 MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE, or 0.105 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 12873, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and confirms a change in place of use under Transfer Application T-7236 recorded in Special Order Volume 49, Page 265, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
