CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the Little Walla Walla River, tributary to the Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION, DOMESTIC AND LIVESTOCK on 5.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority dates are 1891 and 1900.

The use is limited to 1.5 MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE, or 0.207 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above-described decree.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
