## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

Robert Leibbrand 84262 Hwy 339 Milton-Freewater, OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of the Little Walla Walla River, tributary to the Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION on 9.92 ACRES.

This right was perfected under by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority dates are 1879 and 1885.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.222 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 1/40 of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above-described decree.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
