CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the Little Walla Walla River, tributary to the Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION and FROST PROTECTION on 9.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits S-3543 and S-45371. The priority dates are 9/26/17 for IRRIGATION and 11/20/1980 for FROST PROTECTION. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.357 cubic foot per second (cfs), being 0.117 cfs for IRRIGATION and 0.240 cfs for FROST PROTECTION, or their equivalents in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificates 2110 and 64623, State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **MAY - 5 2017**, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificates 2110 and 64623.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
