CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER, tributary to the Walla Walla River for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION on 9.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-43005. The priority date is 5/10/1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
6 N	35 E	WM	35	NW SW	60 FEET SOUTH AND 50 FEET EAST FROM W ¼ CORNER, SECTION 35

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 0.0375 cfs (3/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to compel continuance of the waste water. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 49565, State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 49565.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
