CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of the Little Walla Walla River, tributary to the Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION on 7.5 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION on 7.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permits S-1216 and S-26001. The priority dates are 3/25/1912 for IRRIGATION and 1/16/1959 for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.283 cubic foot per second (cfs), being 0.095 cfs for IRRIGATION and 0.188 cfs for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or their equivalents in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cfs per acre for IRRIGATION, and is limited to 0.0375 cfs (3/80) per acre for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificates 86961 (90699) and 86964 (90700), State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificates 86961 (90699) and 86964 (90700).
