CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the Dugger Creek Basin for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION on 5.02 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10860. The priority date is 11/19/1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.127 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

6 N	35 E	WM	33	NW SE	475 FEET SOUTH AND 140 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER ¼ CORNER OF SECTION 33

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH (1/40) of one cubic foot per second, (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre. The right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land. The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with the prior water rights of others. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 65358, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 5, 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 65358.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
