 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the West Ford Branch of Little Walla Walla River, tributary to the Little Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION on 0.5 ACRE.

This right was perfected by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority date is 1908.

The use is limited to 1.5 MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE, or 0.188 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion in the SESW of SECTION 26, T6N, R35E, W.M.; Morris Ditch – 50 FEET NORTH AND 1295 FEET WEST FROM THE S ¼ CORNER, SECTION 26, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the source.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above-described decree.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

Any water stored in ponds (bulges in the system) may only be stored for the purposes of irrigation and only during the irrigation season.

The water user shall maintain a headgate or other suitable device for controlling the water at the point where water is diverted. It shall be of such construction that it can be locked and kept closed by the Watermaster.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 88426, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate, together with Certificate 92424 supersedes Certificate 88426.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
