CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the West Ford Branch of Little Walla Walla River, for IRRIGATION on 1.53 ACRE.

This right was perfected by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority date is 1902.

The use is limited to 1.5 MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE, or 0.057 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of water for the above described lands is limited to flood waters, or such water as is available in excess of what is required to fill permanent rights having a priority of 1908 or earlier, and which rights run during the irrigation season.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above-described decree.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 13191, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate, together with Certificate 92502, supersedes Certificate 13191.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
