CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the Walla Walla River, a tributary of the Columbia River, routed into the Little Walla Walla River at the control structure located at 7,091 Feet South and 3450 Feet East of the NW Corner of Section 1, T5N, R35E, W.M., for IRRIGATION on 0.49 ACRE.

This right was perfected by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority date is 1903.

The use is limited to 1.5 MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE, or 0.011 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized point of diversion for the right shall be at a point on the East Crocket Branch of the Little Walla Walla River NO °07' W, 612 feet from the Southwest Corner of Section 36, T6N, R35E, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above-described decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 77003, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **MAY - 5 2017**, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate, together with Certificate 92540, supersedes Certificate 77003.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
