 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the confirms the right to use the waters of the Walla Walla River, a tributary of the Columbia River, routed into the Little Walla Walla River at the control structure located at 7,091 Feet South and 3450 Feet East of the NW Corner of Section 1, T5N, R35E, W.M., for IRRIGATION on 0.2 ACRE.

This right was perfected by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority date is 1908.

The use is limited to ONE-FORTIETH (1/40) cubic foot per second (cfs) per acre, or 0.005 cfs, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Note: The 1908 right is limited to the use of surplus water only.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 80967, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate, together with Certificate 92540, supersedes Certificate 80967.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
