 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER, tributary of the Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION on 10.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-13921. The priority date is 6/30/1939. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q
6 N	35 E	WM	28	SE SE

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 0.0375 (3/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be still further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 14489, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 14489.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
