confirms the right to use the WASTE WATER, from the N1/2 of the NE SW, Section 33, T6N R35E and W1/2 of the NW NE, Section 3, T5N R35E, W.M., tributary of the Walla Walla Watershed for SUPPLEMENTAL SUPPLY on 20.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-6677. The priority date is 9/9/1924. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 87606 (7503), State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY = 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate, together with Certificate 92882, supersedes Certificate 87606 (7503).

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
