CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use waste water in the NE1/4 SW1/4, Section 26, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M. and WEST BRANCH of WEST CROCKETT CREEK, tributary to the Walla Walla River for IRRIGATION on 10.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-8177. The priority date is September 23, 1927. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 7964, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 7964.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
