CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

Fred Sams  
Milton-Freewater, OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL, tributary of West Ford Branch of the Little Walla Walla River Basin, tributary to the Columbia River for IRRIGATION on 2.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit U-86. The priority date is 12/14/1934. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.073 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of appropriation is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-THIRTIETH (1/30) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 17070, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **MAY - 5 2017**, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 17070.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
