 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the Ford Branch of the Little Walla Walla River, a tributary of the Walla Walla River, tributary to the Walla Walla River for FROST PROTECTION on 9.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-39035. The priority date is 4/15/1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 1.11 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use described above and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 48083, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 48083.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
