 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER from 4 acres in the NE¼ NE¼, Section 35, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, W.M. IRRIGATION on 6.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-8598. The priority dates are 8/3/1928. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.075 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use described.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 8810, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 8810.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
