CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS, tributary of the Goodman Spring Branch for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION on 0.45 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4580. The priority date is 5/6/1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.006 cubic foot per second (cfs), being 0.003 from each of the two wells, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of appropriation are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 44899, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate, together with Certificate 92595, supersedes Certificate 44899.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
