CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of Ford Branch of the Little Walla Walla River, tributary of the Walla Walla River, tributary to the Columbia River, and Seepage and Waste from the SWNE and SENW of Section 27, T6N, R35E, W.M. for IRRIGATION on 8.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-12124. The priority date is 4/11/1936. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.27 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-THIRTIETH (1/30) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and is also limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and does not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by others. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of water for the above purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use described above.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 12257, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY - 5 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 12257.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
