CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER from the West 14.5 acres of NWNW of Sec. 30, T6N, R35E, W.M., for IRRIGATION on 0.87 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-14450. The priority date is 5/23/1940. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 0.0375 cfs (3/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion, and shall not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by others, and shall be limited still further to a total diversion of not to exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 13818, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered **MAY - 5 2017**, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate, together with Certificate 92660, supersedes Certificate 13818.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
