 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WASTE WATER for IRRIGATION AND DOMESTIC on 1.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-11813. The priority date is 7/20/1935 The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.019 cubic foot per second (cfs), being 0.018 cfs for IRRIGATION and 0.001 cfs for DOMESTIC, or their equivalent in case of rotation.

The points of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall also be limited to the water available at the proposed point of diversion and shall not carry with it the right to divert water from the stream from which the waste water is diverted nor the right to require the wasteful use of water by others. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
