## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of the East Branch of the West Branch of Crockett Creek, tributary of the Little Walla Walla River for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION on 9.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-5515. The priority date is 7/6/1922. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second (cfs).

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state official.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

This certificate describes the water right confirmed by Certificate 5407, State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 5, 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district, diminishing a portion of the water right evidenced by Certificate 5407 from irrigation to supplemental irrigation. This certificate supersedes Certificate 5407.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
