CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GUILD UNITED DITCHES
C/O EDGAR BARTON

UNION, OR 97883

confirms the right to use the waters of the CATHERINE CREEK, a tributary to the GRANDE RONDE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 59.16 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8 at Page 1. The date of priority is 1874.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
4 S	40 E	WM	19	NE NE	150 FEET SOUTH AND 1730 FEET EAST FROM THE N1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19

The right is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre in any irrigation season diverted at the rate of not to exceed one-fortieth of a cubic foot per second per acre.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


The right, to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 57428, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 10 2017, approving Transfer Application T-12196.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
