CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of CATHERINE CREEK, TRIBUTARY TO GRANDE RONDE RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The date of priority is 1874. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from June 27 through October 31.

The description of the stream reach in which flows are to be maintained is as follows:

Reach	Instream Period and Instream Rate June 27 through October 31	
Reach #1	0.01	2.52
Reach #2	0.008	2.02

Reach 1: From the location of the diversion authorized previously under Certificate 57428, located approximately:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
4 S	40 E	WM	19	NE NE	150 FEET SOUTH AND 1730 FEET EAST FROM THE N1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19

Reach 2: To the mouth of Catherine Creek, located approximately as Section 12, T 3S, R 39E, W.M., also identified as (45.3139066500 latitude / -117.8724194308 longitude)

Water rights upstream of the original point of diversion shall not be subject to regulation for flows in excess of the quantities to which this instream water right is entitled at the original point of diversion.

Within the specified stream reach, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion. Stream channel losses and gains calculated based on available data and the use of water by senior appropriators will determine the amount of water to which this right is entitled downstream from the original point of diversion within the specified stream reach.


The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 57428, and any related decree.

This is a final order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 104, Page ~~898~~, approving Transfer T-12196, and along with Certificate, 93003 supersedes Certificate 57428, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
