The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated provided further that the use described herein may be at any time of the year that the use is beneficial. The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein. Provided further that although declared herein, in part, to be for supplemental irrigation, in the interest of the proper operation of the treatment plant and storage lagoons, use of water under this right may be exercised at times when water is available at the primary source, provided that total quantity diverted from all sources does not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.
