confirms the right to the use of waters as limited and conditioned below. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 3, at Page 127.

SOURCE OF WATER: BIRCH CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF THE UMATILLA RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 8.45 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF PARAGRAPH 33 OF THE DECREE AND ALL OTHER CONDITIONS AND LIMITATIONS CONTAINED IN THE DECREE

DATE OF PRIORITY: 1904

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 29, 2004, at Special Order Volume 62, Page 419, approving Transfer Application 9776, and together with Certificate 81001, supercedes Certificate 79859, State record of Water Right Certificates.
