confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-41802. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: LAMBERT SLOUGH, A TRIBUTARY OF WILLAMETTE RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 12.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND

DATE OF PRIORITY: FEBRUARY 28, 1977

The point of diversion is located as follows:

5 S	3 W	WM	10	NW NW	5	430 FEET NORTH AND 80 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, LOT 5

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 26, 2003, at Special Order Volume 58, Page 51, approving Transfer Application 8624, and together with Certificate 80424, supercedes Certificate 48640, State record of Water Right Certificates.
