CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That the Dobbin Ditch Company and assignees -- Silver Lake Ditch Company, Big Bend Water Ditch Company, McCubbin-Craig Ditch Company, Wrehn and Dobbin Ditch Company, Farmers Ditch Company and Creighton Ditch Company, of Joseph, State of Oregon, have made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of Wallowa River for the purposes of irrigation, domestic and supplemental irrigation, to be appropriated under Permit No. 2896, under Reservoir Permit No. 347 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 9, 1915; that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 44,000 acre-feet, and to be apportioned as follows:

Creighton Ditch Company	1,503	acre-feet
Silver Lake Ditch Company	10,023	acre-feet
Big Bend Water Ditch Company	8,018	acre-feet
McCubbin-Craig Ditch Company	401	acre-feet
Wrehn & Dobbin Ditch Company	6,014	acre-feet
Farmers Ditch Company	10,023	acre-feet

The reservoir is located in Sections 4, 5, 8, 9, 16, 17, 20 and 21, Township 3 South, Range 45 East, W. M.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of Section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
