CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO:

confirms the right to use the waters of the WASTE WATER from the H.S. Shangle Ranch, for IRRIGATION on 8.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12 at Page 9. The priority dates is 1904.

The use is limited to 1.5 MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE, or 0.327 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described, and the right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the above-described decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate is issued to correct an error describing a point of diversion and supersedes Certificate 92476, which described the water right confirmed by Certificate 86969 (12604), State Record of Water Right Certificates, modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 5, 2017, approving a petition by Walla Walla River Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate supersedes Certificate 92476.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
