confirms the right to the use of water perfected under the terms of Permit S-39059. The amount of water used to which this right is entitled is limited to the amount used beneficially, and shall not exceed the amount specified, or its equivalent in the case of rotation, measured at the point(s) of diversion from the source. The specific limits and conditions of the use are listed below.

SOURCE OF WATER: SOUTH YAMHILL RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF YAMHILL RIVER

PURPOSE OR USE: IRRIGATION OF 68.2 ACRES

MAXIMUM RATE: 0.85 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS)

DATE OF PRIORITY: MAY 7, 1974 FOR 0.3 CFS AND 0.55 CFS FOR JUNE 3, 1974

The point of diversion is located as follows:

5 S	5 W	WM	35	NW SW	71	POD 5 - 2180 FEET NORTH AND 510 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 35

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Water use measurement conditions:

- a. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices in good working order at each point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- b. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion described as follows:

The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the place of use described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved, superseded, and corrected by an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCTOBER 17, 2016, at Special Order Volume 103, Page 147, approving Transfer Application 11478, supersedes Certificate 47042, State record of Water Right Certificates.
